
President's Ramblings

Activities begin Sunday afternoon, April 16th and three days of touring begins Monday morning. The annual member's meeting will be held Monday afternoon with a farewell banquet on Wednesday evening April 19th after a day of touring. This is a big-car tour, and only strong 2-cylinder cars should attend. Tuesday's tour will be 100 miles with moderate hills.

Period clothing is optional and not required. Dusters over modern clothes is appreciated. All cars must be pre-16 and drivers HCCA members. Tour headquarters will be at the Visalia Marriott Convention Center. Reservations at the Marriott must be made separate from the Tour.
